Full Scholarship Award Information

(Limited Availability - Ages 12+)

The Full Tuition Scholarship provides a unique opportunity for aspiring young performers to participate in an immersive theater camp experience at no cost. This prestigious scholarship is awarded to students who demonstrate a passion for the performing arts, academic dedication, and a strong commitment to personal growth through theater.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must submit the following:

- Completed Application
- Most Recent Report Card
- Two Reference Letters (from teachers, directors, or mentors)
- Video Audition
 - One vocal selection (*not from the show*)
 - One monologue (*under one minute*)
- Personal Essay (Five Paragraphs)
 - Respond to the question:
 "How has your experience in theater shaped you, and where do you hope it will lead? How will participating in this camp propel you?"

PERSONAL ESSAY GUIDELINES:

Your essay should be structured as follows:

- 1. Introduction Introduce your passion for theater and the impact it has had on your life.
- 2. **Growth Through Theater** Share specific experiences that have shaped your skills, confidence, and character.
- 3. **Future Aspirations** Describe your goals in theater or how it will influence your future career path.
- 4. **Impact of This Camp** Explain how this opportunity will help you grow as a performer and individual.
- 5. **Conclusion** Summarize your dedication to the arts and why you are a deserving candidate for this scholarship.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Be sure to review the **Full Scholarship Application** for any additional guidelines. Applications that are incomplete or do not follow the outlined instructions may not be considered.
- This scholarship is a competitive opportunity, so take the time to craft a thoughtful application that reflects your dedication and passion for theater!

- All application materials must be submitted **by June 16th**.
